**Medium:** Please use the paper provided to ensure all posters are the same size: pen and ink, felt markers, crayons or pencil crayon, paint, collage, computer art, etc., may be used to decorate - be creative! Designs should be submitted in full color.

**Size:** All posters must be on **11x17** inch paper to be considered. Free paper requests must be submitted to [louisa.franco@longbeach.gov](mailto:louisa.franco@longbeach.gov) by **Feb 27<sup>th</sup>**.

**Content:** Posters can include words and/or images that promote walking and describe why you think ***It's Cool to Walk to School!*** Only original artwork will be considered.
